Leaving prison can be an exciting but daunting time. You have a lot to deal with and to succeed, you need to take your time. A structured approach, using all the support available to you will assist you in moving on.

Our five-step approach will help you settle back into the community and maximise any opportunities that may be available to you.

Our dedicated 'Through the Gate Team' will work with you and support you in your release from prison and help you to integrate back into the communities where you belong.

## Reception into custody

Working with remand and sentenced prisoners within five days of reception by focussing on immediate needs and completing a resettlement plan.

## Rehabilitation and resettlement support in custody

Preparing for release throughout the custodial sentence.

## Pre-release support

Within 12 weeks of release – our team will support and prepare for your release.

## On-release

Our team will support you at the point of your release to help prevent you from re-offending. The Durham and Tees Valley Community Rehabilitation Company will provide you with additional support and identify any programmes that may benefit you.

## Post-release support

The Through the Gate Team will inform your Offender Manager of your progress and ongoing needs and you will receive support in the community throughout your supervision or licence period.
